#### THE KENTUCKY CASTLE

What royal itinerary would be complete without a spot of tea? Downtown Versailles' Main Street is undergoing a good old-fashioned small town rejuvenation, with the Amsden a literal and figurative cornerstone. Enjoy some hot tea, a pastry, and all the charm this quaint town has to offer!

#### GODOLPHIN AT JONABELL 2:30pm – 4pm

Godolphin is the global thoroughbred breeding and racing operation owned by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President and Prime Minister of the United Arab Emirates and Ruler of Dubai. If that isn't regal enough, the farm is home to three Kentucky Derby winners and the tour includes a visit to the trophy room.
