Spy Coast Farm – 10:30 am – 12:00noon

Spy Coast is known for specializing in breeding and training top quality performance horses. Guests will be given the opportunity to drive through the property to see the construction of new facilities and learn about current facilities including the Rehabilitation and Fitness Center, CEM Quarantine, Breeding Shed, Show Barn, and Foaling Barn. CLAIBORNE 10am – 11am

A leader in the Thoroughbred farm industry for generations, Claiborne is famously home to the grave of Secretariat, widely believed to be one of the best racehorses of all time. Steeped in history and a commitment to ‘doing the usual, unsually well’, Claiborne is home to top stallions Runhappy, Orb, and War Front.

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
